Count one, two, three	<u>Position</u> Talk about the position of objects and give your child simple instructions to follow. For example: - Put the teddy on the bed - Push the chair under the table - Put your toys in the box	<u>Shape</u> Point out 2D shapes around the home and your local environment. (circle, triangle, square, rectangle) For example: - the clock is a circle - the door is a rectangle - the table is a square - the roof is a triangle - the plate is a circle

<u>Number</u> Sing some number songs together and say the number names in order. For example: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish a live - Five little ducks went swimming one day - Five currant buns in a bakers shop - Five green speckled frogs	<u>Size</u> Compare the size of different things. For example: The banana is big, the grapes are small. The path is narrow the drive is wide	<u>Capacity</u> Explore water and use the language full and empty. For example: - When your child is in the bath let them fill and empty different containers. - When your child has a drink talk about how much they have.	<u>Weight</u> Unpack the shopping and compare how heavy and light different objects are. For example: - The bag of potatoes are heavy - The crisps are light - The box of cereal is light - The 2 litre bottle of pop is heavy
	<u>Number</u> Explore and count different movements. (jump, clap, hop) For example: jump and count the jumps	<u>Position</u> Talk about the where you find different animals For example; - The bird is in the tree. - The rabbit is under the ground in the hole.
