

# Ranskill Primary School Nursery Nappy, Potty and Toileting Policy



Whether children wear nappies or have started using a potty and toilet, all children are welcome at Ranskill Primary School.

Only staff members who hold a valid DBS certificate will be allowed to change nappies, assist children with toileting, and help them change into clean clothes after a toileting accident.

## Nappy Changing and Toileting Facilities

Children will have access to the following nappy changing and toileting facilities:

- Plastic potties
  - Plastic toilet seats
  - 3x Child accessible toilets with foot-stools
  - 3x Child accessible sinks
  - Hand dryer and paper towel dispenser
  - Built in nappy changing table with fold-away steps
- If a child prefers a particular type of potty or toilet seat, parents/carers are welcome to supply their own.

## Hygiene Practices

Children will be taught thorough hand-washing techniques and will be required to wash their hands with soap and water after nappy changes, using the potty/toilet, and wet or soiled accidents.

This will be done every time, whether or not they were successful at producing anything.

Adults also wash their hands after assisting children with toileting. We will risk assess the setting to ensure that nappy-changing facilities, toilets, potties, and surrounding areas are kept clean and hygienic.
