



Remote Learning – Home / School Agreement

Ranskill Primary School



School will...

- ✓ Provide a mixture of live lessons, independent activities and other relevant tasks (i.e on SPaG.com, oak national academy, bbc bitesize etc.) to continue learning at home
- ✓ Respond to completed assignments/tasks through Office 365 and Class Dojo
- ✓ Provide appropriate tasks for all pupils which sets the same expectations as would face-to-face learning (as much as possible)
- ✓ Contact parents/carers of pupils who do not log in to live lessons to check in on them and ask if they require support
- ✓ Occasionally record live lessons for monitoring purposes or to share with pupils unable to make the lesson.
- ✓ Offer pupils the opportunity to ask for extra help if they do not understand
- ✓ Keep in regular contact with all families

Pupils will...

- ✓ Complete work and activities set by their teachers
- ✓ Attend all live lessons unless they have a genuine reason that they are unable to. (Please be aware that pupils will be visible to and heard by their class peers and school staff when in a live session)
- ✓ Find a quiet place to join their live lesson and have any equipment necessary (books, pencil, ruler, whiteboard and pen, etc.)
- ✓ Use the 'Raise your hand' and Chat functions as well as responding to directed questions to participate in the lesson
- ✓ Remain on mute unless the teacher asks for them to unmute
- ✓ Turn their video function off unless the teacher asks to see them
- ✓ Focus on learning during the live lesson and complete activities and other follow-up work
- ✓ Use the chat function appropriately, this is not a social media chatroom
- ✓ Remember class expectations still apply - always adhere to the School Behaviour Policy

Parents/Carers will ...

- ✓ Ensure their child is following a daily timetable (usually via work set and joining any live lessons at the correct time) and help them to complete their work (when possible) to avoid lost learning time whilst at home
- ✓ Ensure their child only uses the platforms for educational purposes and be available to support live lessons if possible
- ✓ Ensure their child has a quiet and appropriate place to learn (eg – TV/music not on for others to hear, the background is suitable for other pupils to see, family members will not be walking in and out of shot etc.)
- ✓ Monitor the use of their devices for access of other online materials and apps
- ✓ Let the school know if their child has any technical issues with accessing online learning
- ✓ Not record or take photos of the screen whilst live lessons are taking place
- ✓ Report any absences as usual, via the school office—including COVID 19 symptoms or positive test results for the child or someone
